St. George Fire Protection District Announces Important Public Meetings

The St. George District is seeking two tax measures on the May, 2 ballot. One is a revenue replacement proposition to replace revenue generated by a 1.25 mill capital improvements tax that expires this year. The second proposition is a 2.0 mill tax. Both are dedicated to capital improvements and general operations.

The passage of both measures will increase the current taxes paid by St. George Fire Protection District's citizens by a total of 2 mills. This will bring the total taxes to 16 mills, keeping them the lowest supporting a career department in the area.

Also, the passage of both will allow the Department to continue its construction program, building, equipping and staffing a a station in the Bluebonnet/Nicholson area as well as other improvements that will move the District to or very near a Class 1 Rating.

As is our history with every tax measure we have brought to the people, we will host public meetings to allow any and all members of the public to ask their questions about these issues directly to the Fire Chief and senior staff.
